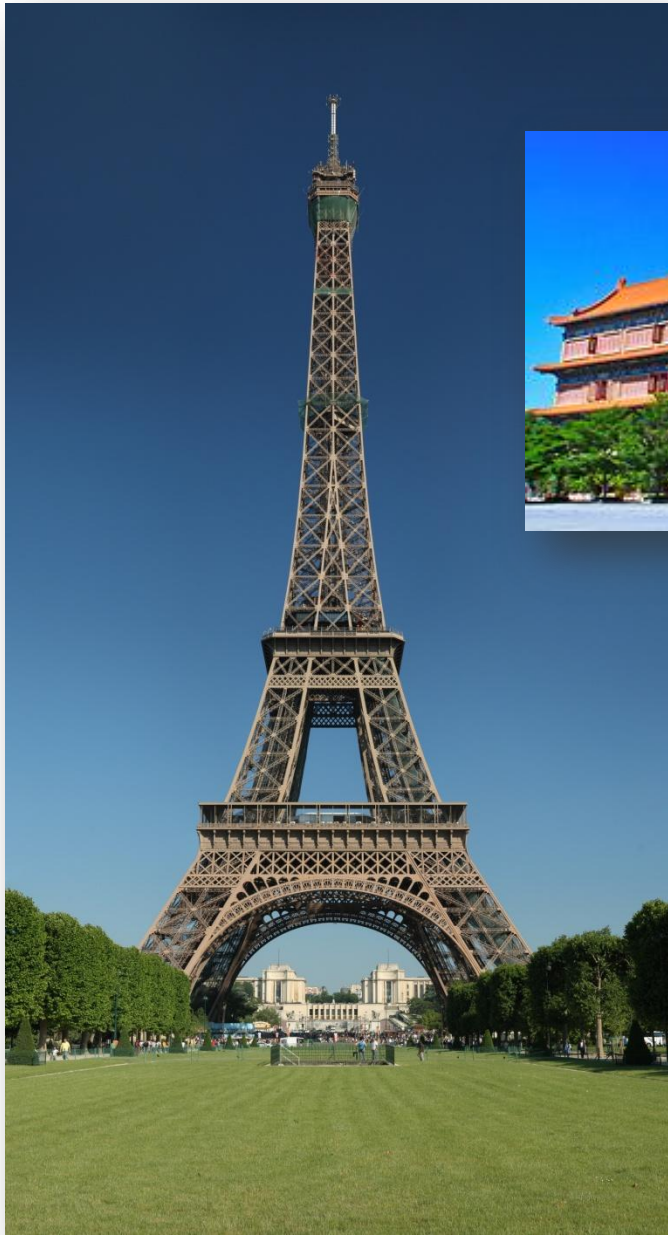
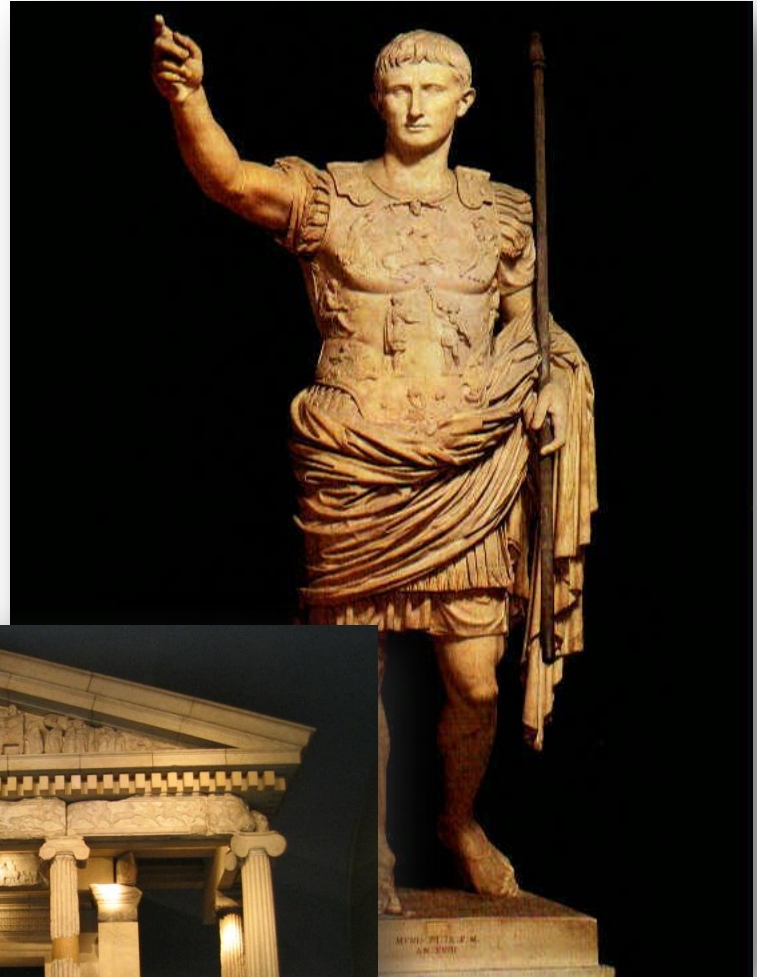




St. Luke: Lindisfarne Gospels, 698 A.D.

“Savior, Christ the Lord”





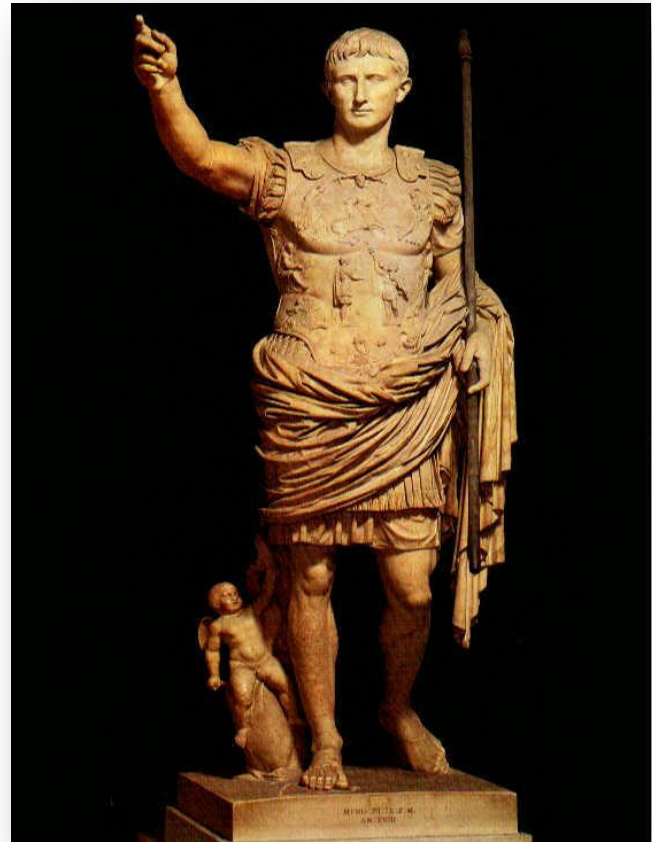


Luke, symbolized as one of the Four Living Creatures in Heaven.

- *Luke 1:1-4 NIV*
- *Many have undertaken to draw up an account of the things that have been fulfilled among us, ² just as they were handed down to us by those who from the first were eyewitnesses and servants of the word. ³ With this in mind, since I myself have carefully investigated everything from the beginning, I too decided to write an orderly account for you, most excellent Theophilus, ⁴ so that you may know the certainty of the things you have been taught.*

Anchored on the world stage:

- *Luke 2:1-3 NIV*
- *In those days Caesar Augustus issued a decree that a census should be taken of the entire Roman world. ² (This was the first census that took place while Quirinius was governor of Syria.) ³ And everyone went to their own town to register.*



Birthed in Bethlehem:

- *Luke 2:4 NIV*
- *So Joseph also went up from the town of Nazareth in Galilee to Judea, to Bethlehem the town of David, because he belonged to the house and line of David.*



Heaven's birth announcement:

- *Luke 2:10-12 NIV*
- *But the angel said to them, “Do not be afraid. I bring you good news that will cause great joy for all the people.
¹¹ Today in the town of David a Savior has been born to you; he is the Messiah, the Lord.
¹² This will be a sign to you: You will find a baby wrapped in cloths and lying in a manger.”*
