## *Galatians 4:1-3 Kingdom New Testament*

*Let me put it like this. As long as the heir is a child, he is no different from a slave – even if, in fact, he is master of everything!*

*He is kept under guardians and stewards until the time set by his father.*

*Well, it's like that with us. When we were children, we were kept in "slavery" under the "elements of the world."*
