John 2:3 NIV

When the wine ran out, Jesus' mother told him, "They don't have any more wine."

John 2:4 N/V

"Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come."

John 2:5 NIV

His mother said to the servants, "Do whatever he tells you."

John 2:6-7 NIV

Nearby stood six stone jars, the kind used by the Jews for ceremonial washing, each holding from twenty to thirty gallons.

Jesus said to the servants, "Fill the jars with water"; so they filled them to the brim.

John 2:8 N/V

John 2:8b-9a NIV
