Mark 1:10-11 NIV

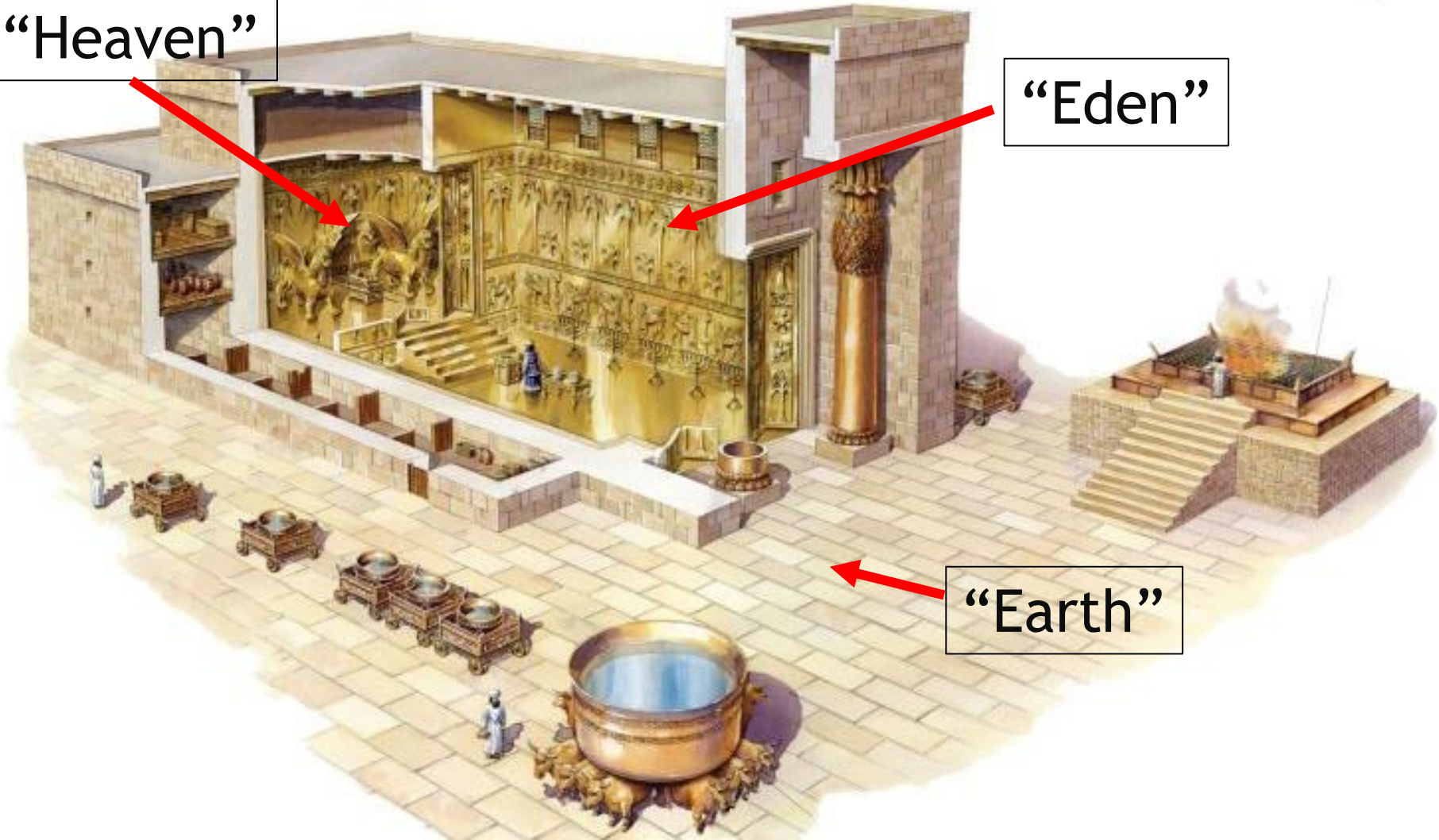
