




ARE WE THERE YET?





Mt. Hermon: site of Jesus'
Transfiguration

Exodus 24:15-18 NIV

When Moses went up on the mountain, the cloud covered it, and the glory of the LORD settled on Mount Sinai. For 6 days the cloud covered the mountain, and on the 7th day the LORD called to Moses from within the cloud. To the Israelites the glory of the LORD looked like a consuming fire on top of the mountain. Then Moses entered the cloud as he went up on the mountain. And he stayed on the mountain 40 days and 40 nights.

Mark 9:3 NIV

His clothes became dazzling white, whiter than anyone in the world could bleach them.

Mark 9:5-6 NIV amended

Peter said to Jesus, “Rabbi, it is good for us to be here. Let us put up 3 tents – one for you, one for Moses and one for Elijah.” (He did not know what to say, they were so frightened.)

Mark 9:7-8 NIV

Then a cloud appeared and covered them, and a voice came from the cloud:

“This is my Son, whom I love. Listen to him!”

Suddenly, when they looked around, they no longer saw anyone with them except Jesus.

Deuteronomy 18:15 NIV

“The LORD your God will raise up for you a prophet like me from among you, from your fellow Israelites. You must listen to him.”

Mark 9:9-10 NIV

As they were coming down the mountain, Jesus gave them orders not to tell anyone what they had seen until the Son of Man had risen from the dead. They kept the matter to themselves, discussing what “rising from the dead” meant.
