On the third day a wedding took place at Cana in Galilee. Jesus' mother was there, and Jesus and his disciples had also been invited to the wedding.

John 2:3 NIV

"When the wine was gone, Jesus' mother said to him, "They have no more wine."

John 2:4 NIV

"Woman, why do you involve me?" Jesus replied. "My hour has not yet come."

John 2:5 NIV

"Do whatever he tells you."

John 2:8b-10 NIV
